1. Jake has a ribbon that is 8 inches long, and Emma has a ribbon that is 12 inches long. How much longer is Emma's ribbon than Jake's?

2. The length of a rectangular table is 5 feet, and the length of a rectangular rug is 3 feet. How much longer is the table than the rug?

3. Amy's jump rope is 7 feet long, and Ben's jump rope is 9 feet long. How much longer is Ben's jump rope than Amy's?

4. A caterpillar crawled for 6 centimeters, and a snail crawled for 4 centimeters. How much longer did the caterpillar crawl than the snail?

5. Sarah drew two lines on her paper. The first line is 15 inches long, and the second line is 10 inches long. How much longer is the first line than the second?

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
